

### ADVENTUREACH 2024 YEARLY UPDATE

Thank you for partnering with us creating life-changing outdoor adventures to help kids develop genuine relationships and strong character so that they can resolve conflict and overcome negative life influences and thrive in healthy community. This year has been extraordinary thanks to you and your support. Here are some highlights.

Tears welled up in this mom's eyes. It was happening again - the same response we saw from countless parents when we asked, "What would you like to say to those who support Adventureach and make this ministry possible – many of whom don't have children at AR, don't even live nearby, and have never been out here to see the outcome of their support?" She was taken aback. "That is amazing that you have such supporters. Wow!" she said as she paused to contemplate. Tears rolling - the depth of emotion was palpable as she reached for tissues - "THANK YOU."

This just begins to scratch the surface of the thanks offered to **you**, our supporters. Your support is transforming kids and altering their life trajectories! If you know the deep desire a parent has for the well-being of their child, you can begin to fathom the depth of gratitude expressed by more than 300 parents whose children have been enriched, strengthened, and, for some, even saved! Your gracious gifts enable these parents to realize the hopes and dreams they have for their kids.

One of our young men, for the first time, experienced life and unconditional love. He witnessed the love we have for each other and for him. He softened. He heard truth. He was surrounded by it. Courageously and boldly, he proclaimed his lack of faith was not based on reason. We all felt his pain. He acknowledged that he still has a wall around his heart. He asked for and welcomed prayer.

We invite you to pray with us. We implore you to pray for us and for these kids.

Another young boy, right before the first game began on his first day at Fall Teams said, "Thank you guys for inviting me to Teams. It means a lot to me that you guys want me here cause, usually people don't." These interactions are so encouraging to

us. When we hear them, we are reminded that the work that we do here is vital and impactful. We are so grateful to be a part of this team.

A young girl at the beginning of her first day was sullen, slumped in her chair. She didn't want to be at camp. By Friday she had been transformed - bright-eyed and hopeful. That week she testified to her acceptance and her understanding of the hope that is in us. Seven months later, on her first day at Teams, her new life radiated for all to see and enjoy! She told us, "You helped me find God again along with actual happiness." "What you guys do at Adventureach is powerful and rooted in God's Word."

We get to see these kids come and we are amazed at the speed and extent of their growth. Their understanding of truth is rapidly expanding, and their character and spiritual maturation exceeds our expectations. "The body is built up in love when each individual part plays its part" - Thank you for playing your part and being with us! This is only a glimpse of what we see before us - the continuing story of what God is doing.

#### NEXT FALL WILL BE OUR TENTH YEAR! WE ARE SO AMAZED AT WHERE WE NOW ARE.

Over 160 youth are engaged in consistent character-building discipleship and lifechanging outdoor adventure. We see God's providence every step of the way. Looking forward, we see a greater vision for an even deeper and wider impact.

We stopped advertising AR when our ministry reached 40 kids, but we have continued to grow exponentially. We opened registration for our 2024 summer camps and within days they were full, and we had 56 kids on a waiting list. By God's grace, we were able to add a camp and run seven camps this summer for 250 youth. As the demand swells, we still feel called to all those who would come, but it's a challenge at the rate they are coming.

Kids are coming to Christ and are being discipled and are having an impact in their homes and in their communities. We sense God is turning the next page. He is opening exciting new opportunities that we will be sharing with you in the coming year.



This summer we had over 250 participants across all our summer camps. **Fall Teams: September - November** 

This fall we currently have 160 young men and women in weekly discipleship as part of our Fall Teams program. We launched our full Fall Teams program at our Saint Mary's location at the Kings Christian Academy. Last year we started at KCA with a beta program and invited 12. This Fall we have 36! We ask you to pray for us as we try to accommodate all those who would like to come and for those who are able, please consider supporting us. We need to raise an additional \$40,000 just to continue at our current numbers.



(Of course, epic battles as well) This year we have 150 participants coming and we are excited to help root and ground them in their faith and in the Word.

"These kids are making memories that will last a lifetime. You are setting them up for the Christian walk - the Christian life. You don't try to put rose colored glasses on them – that everything is going to be fine - you prepare them, knowing that it is going to be a fight – that there is a battle. You do this in a healthy way. And I think that they are going to take these lessons everywhere they go.
